



Mask Considerations – April 2021

AFC encourages all participants and attendees to follow the most current information provided by the CDC and PA Department of Health.

- We know that there are individuals who are gravely concerned about COVID-19 and would like everyone to be wearing masks.
- We know that there are individuals who are gravely concerned about wearing masks due to medical exemptions, vaccinations, etc.

Our challenge to all our players and attendees is to encourage folks in both camps to respect both sets of viewpoints. Mutual respect is necessary so that play may continue. Please remember that participation and attendance is a choice, and social distancing is encouraged.

The PA Department of Health “Face Covering Order” is not 100% enforceable, and so our participants cannot expect to have a 100% response to each situation.

Mask concerns will NOT be handled on site by attendees, coaches, players, or game officials.

Organizations/Coaches will be responsible for sharing this information with their families before the season starts. Having this information beforehand will help families make the best decision that works for them. This will also help to mitigate any encounters that will lead to the removal of individuals and possible cancellation of play.
